## Members of the Minority Messengers HUB - Steering Team

...to work together with a dedicated team on the "State of Play of Young People from Minorities in Europe". With this document, that should be ready by the end of the year 2020, we want to strengthen our position in civil society and the connections within our network, partners and European institutions by:

- a) documenting and making the outcomes of our seminars 2018-2020 more visible by summarizing the three-year programme of Minority Messengers;
- b) sharing our expertise, data and knowledge from working with minority youth, filling in this way a "content gap" on the current state of play of minorities in Europe, and make it accessible to European institutions, youth organizations, our network etc.; and
- c) providing a tool for lobbying and information.

The document will be developed through a process lasting all of 2020 (called the Minority Messengers HUB).

### Preferred requirements

- Experience with minorities, YEN and the Minority Messengers Project
- Creative mind, thinking out of the box
- Analysing skills, critical thinking
- Motivated and eager to learn
- Writing skills (English or German)
- Able to organise own time effectively
- Available for all LABS and to work on the project throughout the year 2020

- Development and improvement of skills and know-how regarding analysing, evaluating and processing data and embedding them in a greater context
- Balance between specific training and gaining first-hand experience
- A participatory process with specific focus on critical thinking
- Opportunity to make the youth perspective accessible to European institutions and youth organizations in a sustainable way
- Expenses related to the project (e.g. travel, accommodation, food) will be reimbursed
- Positive team and learning environment



## Steering Team

We are looking to form a team with an emphasis on the diversity among the members, the knowledge, skills and competencies. Team members complement each other and become an effective, strong, and enthusiastic team. This also means that one candidate does not necessarily need to fulfil all requirements. However, it may happen that you are not selected for the team. Please do not take this personally since there will be other opportunities to contribute to the project with your expertise.

**The Steering Team** will meet for three Laboratories (Lab´s) during 2020. The planned dates are:

- Lab 3: 29<sup>th</sup> October-1<sup>st</sup> November 2020

The members of the Steering Team are expected to take part in all three Lab's and to be willing to work on tasks for the HUB throughout the year. The venues of the meetings will be decided later.
