I also have over 3 years of experience working as a team leader and over 2 years of experience working in coordinating projects as an organiser of Between.Pomiędzy Festival of Literature and Theatre and Educational Project Between.Edukacja: Kosmopolis 2020. As a project coordinator, I worked with team of both students and more experienced researchers. I was also in charge of documentation of the Between.Pomiędzy Foundation.

I know English on an advanced level (C1) and I have a BA degree in art management. This is my last year of cultural studies. I would be thrilled to share my experience with board as well as with working group and to help our community continue to take its background in minority issues into real action. At the same time, I see it as a great opportunity to improve my knowledge and competences.
