Application for the Position of Convenor for Minority Rights and Politics at the

Organization Youth of European Nationalities

Dear YEN Members,

I am writing to express my keen interest in applying for the position of Convenor for Minority

Rights and Politics at the Organization Youth of European Nationalities. With my extensive

experience in minority affairs and my passion for promoting minority rights and political

participation, I am confident that I can make a valuable contribution to our organization.

Since my childhood, I have been part of the German minority in Poland. In 2018, I became a

member of the Youth of the German Minority (BJDM) and early on learned to appreciate the

importance of cultural diversity and minority rights. My journey began with the International

Summer Camp in 2018 in Czechia, where I had the opportunity to meet young representatives

of the German minority from 13 countries. These experiences motivated me to actively

advocate for the concerns of minorities and to be their voice. I founded a local group, was

elected treasurer of the board in 2020, and assumed the position of president of the BJDM in

2022.

During my tenure as president, I have gained extensive experience in the field of minority

politics. In particular, the struggle against discrimination of the German minority in the

education system has strengthened my determination to advocate for justice and equal

opportunities. In 2022, the German minority in Poland was clearly discriminated against by a

decision of the Minister of Education - our German language classes were reduced from three

hours to one hour per week, while other minorities were not affected. As a result, I

participated in several meetings at the Federal Ministry of the Interior in Berlin and at the

German Embassy in Warsaw. I appeared publicly on television and was also involved in a

meeting with the Polish Minister of Education, Czarnek, in 2023. I have learned to collaborate

with government authorities and other relevant stakeholders to effect positive change.

Furthermore, in collaboration with the European Youth Parliament (EYP) in Poland, I co-

organized a National Session in Lodz for approximately 150 people (delegates and experts),

where the protection of minority languages was one of the main topics. This event received

wide media attention and challenged the majority society to engage with this issue.

Additionally, through my academic background, I have gained a solid understanding of

European politics and intercultural relations. Currently, I am studying Management and the

Europa Master, a trinational program in Oppeln, Mainz, and Dijon. This program prepares me

to understand complex political challenges at the European level and to develop innovative

solutions.

As the Convenor for Minority Rights and Politics at the Organization Youth of European

Nationalities, I see the opportunity to contribute my experiences and knowledge to represent

the interests of minorities at the European level and to strengthen their political participation. I

am ready to engage fully in this important task and to effect positive changes together with

your team.
